



Academic-related Grants (Graduate students)

The College has a number of funds to support graduate students in their academic work. As well as awarding grants for projects relating to the fulfilment of course requirements (e.g. field trips), the Loans & Grants Committee would like to provide support for relevant conference attendance in the UK and abroad. Support may also be given for focused projects that might fall outside the strict requirements of a course, but which will enhance an applicant's understanding of their field of study.

Please note: Books purchased with a grant award (excepting the Freshers' Book Fund) must be donated to the College Library once the student has graduated.

Who can apply?

Graduate students in any subject.

Money available: Applications may be made each term but the maximum amount per student per year is £260 (2015/16: £250). Unspent allowance may be rolled over to the next year up until the final year of study. DPhil students are encouraged to apply for a maximum of £90 towards the cost of thesis printing and binding.
